## School Psychologist

### Purpose of the Job

Provide services to children being assessed for eligibility for special education or eligible for special education.

### Essential Job Functions

1. Attend building Teacher Assistance Team meetings and participate in prevention activities, screening, consultations, referrals, etc.
2. Complete initial, transfer, and reassessment of students according to State of Washington Regulations.
3. Conduct MDT meetings and recommend services.
4. Provide treatment services for behavior disorders to eligible special education students whether documented behavior disorder or not.
5. Provide suggestions to staff on how to meet eligible special education students' academic needs.
6. Provide consultation services to parents of eligible special education students.
7. Participate in the further development and improvement of our services through our Student Performance Enhancement Committee efforts.
