

“Child with Red Hat”

SQUIGGLES WITH EYES

(Grade K Print: “Child with Red Hat” by Cassatt)

CURRICULUM CONNECTION: History and science, painting techniques, printing technique

ART CONCEPT: Types of line and Primary colors (EALR grade K # 1.1.1, 1.1.2)

MEDIUM: Paint

GRADE LEVEL: K and up

TIME: two 20 to 30 minute sessions

MATERIALS: White construction paper
Four colors of tempera for back ground
Magenta, red, gold, yellow
Black tempera paint
White tempera paint
Watercolor brushes

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Paint wide stripes or sections of each of the background colors across the sheet of paper. It is okay if the sections run together. Let dry.**
- 2. Fold the dry background paper in half.**
- 3. Open the paper to flat position.**
- 4. Using a medium to small watercolor brush apply black paint to one half section of the paper. Make wiggly lines starting from the bottom edge moving up toward the top.**
- 5. Refold the paper to print the wet black lines onto the other half of the picture.**
- 6. Open the paper.**
- 7. Dip the eraser end of the pencil into white paint to create eyes on the black wiggly lines.**
- 8. Using a smaller object or the tip of the brush put one black dot in the center of each white spot.**
