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# Dream Chambers

**Surrealism:** A 20th-century literary and artistic movement that attempts to express the workings of the subconscious and is characterized by fantastic imagery and incongruous juxtaposition of subject matter.

**When?** The phrase was first coined in 1917 by Guillaume Apollinaire but is now used for the movement started by Andre' Breton in 1924.

**Where?** Germany & France

**Who to remember?** Rene' Magritte and Salvador Dali'

**Remember the work:** Personal Values, *The Persistence of Memory*

## *Dream Chambers*

**Step 1:** Think about the dreams and/or nightmares you've had that really stand out in your memory. Try to put those memories down on paper in the form of some sketches

**Step 2:** Fold a piece of 6" x 18" paper in thirds so that you have three 6" sections. Cut a large window in the center third. Tape the ends to each other so that you are left with a triangle. Refer to the pictures for an example.

**Step 3:** Using any materials you wish (eg.-magazines clippings, cut paper, pipe cleaners, etc.), create a three-dimensional representation of the dream or nightmare you've chosen.
