

PORTRAIT

Materials

Magazine photograph of a human face. Picture should fill up most of the page.

12x18" white paper

Pencil and eraser

Ruler

Blending stick

Steps

1. Draw 10 of each: eyes, noses, and mouths, with shading, looking at pictures.
2. Choose a magazine picture of a person, with all features showing (i.e. no masks, sunglasses, etc.) Have instructor approve the picture.
3. Grid the magazine picture 1x1" with your ruler.
4. Grid 12x18" white paper 1 ½ X 1 ½ ", lightly in pencil (you will erase this later).
5. Mark your rows and columns A,B,C...,1,2,3,... on magazine picture and drawing paper, in corresponding squares
6. Outline hair and face, drawing each square, one by one.
7. Draw facial features. Make sure each feature is in the correct square.
8. Erase grid
9. Shade face, hair, clothes

Rubric:

1. Follow directions well. Corresponding squares are drawn.
2. Picture shows volume and smooth shading, using pencil.
3. Careful attention to detail. High level of craftsmanship.
4. Facial features are proportionate.
5. Grid is erased.
