NETWORK SERVER ANALYST Technology Department

Purpose of the Job

Administration and management of all servers, storage, and network devices within an enterprise-class network. Provides engineering design, administration, and support for all IT infrastructure components, including, but not limited to: networking, servers, and telephone system.

Essential Job Functions

- 1 Primary support and subject matter expert for all core infrastructure systems
- 2 Administer and maintain enterprise server environment, utilizing multiple operating systems (both Windows and Linux), physical and virtual, utilizing primarily VMware vSphere.
- 3 Administer and maintain both SAN and NAS storage appliances
- 4 Monitor, maintain, and troubleshoot large network environment, including but not limited to: Cisco WAN/LAN (including L2/L3 switches) NGFW firewall/content filter, Ruckus wireless, and VOIP telephone system.
- 5 Maintain and assist (with Developer position) integration of Microsoft Office 365's suite of applications, utilizing Single Sign-On and ADFS.
- 6 Manage workstations, utilizing Microsoft System Center suite
- 7 Manage large, district-wide deployment of virtual desktop infrastructure (VDI) desktops
- 8 Configuration, management, and support of interconnected network devices (IoT), such as security, access control, video surveillance, HVAC, sprinklers, etc.
- 9 Provide direct support to users, and technology department staff, for issues involving network and server infrastructure, and as directed by the Technology Supervisor.
- 10 Other related duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

Education & Experience:

- 1 High School Diploma required.
- 2 Minimum of Associates Degree in Computer Science, Computer Information Systems, or closely related field, or relevant experience.
- 3 Subject matter expert level competency on Microsoft server and desktop platforms, including Windows Server 2016, Active Directory, and Windows 10.
- 4 Minimum 3 years' experience administering an enterprise-class network (primarily Cisco), utilizing fiber WAN/LAN, L3 routing, VLANs, and next-generation firewalls. Advanced knowledge of Cisco IOS utilizing CLI.
- 5 Minimum 3 years' experience administering large-scale virtualization environments utilizing VMware ESXi and vCenter.
- 6 Minimum 3 years' experience administering enterprise-class converged infrastructure components, specifically Cisco UCS and Pure Storage SAN.
- 7 Experience implementing and managing large VDI environment utilizing VMware Horizon View.
- 8 Administration of Linux servers.
- 9 All aspects of management of Microsoft Office 365 suite of applications.
- 10 Experience administering Voice Over IP (VOIP) telephone systems, preferably ShoreTel.
- 11 Experience working in an academic/educational environment.

Knowledge Skills & Abilities:

1. Strong analytical and troubleshooting skills.
2. Ability to manage multiple tasks or projects simultaneously.
3. Ability to work effectively in a high stress, high demand environment.
4. Ability to effectively manage, and complete, multiple tasks or projects; simultaneously, independently, and without direct supervision.
5. Strong interpersonal skills and ability to communicate technical information to non-technical staff.
