

HOLIDAYS

The district will observe the following school holidays and will not operate on these days:

- A. Sunday;
- B. New Year's Day (January 1);
- C. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday in January);
- D. President's Day (third Monday in February);
- E. Memorial Day (last Monday in May);
- F. Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day (first Monday in September);
- G. Labor Day;
- H. Veteran's Day (November 11);
- I. Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November);
- J. The day after Thanksgiving; and
- K. Christmas Day (December 25).

Whenever any legal holiday, other than a Sunday, falls on Sunday, the following Monday will be a legal holiday and whenever any legal holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday will be a legal holiday.

In addition to the above, the following will also be considered to be holidays: the day before Christmas or the day after Christmas and the day before New Year's Day (December 24 or December 26 and December 31 or January 2). These days will be decided upon annually, at the district's discretion.
