Understanding the Information

Categories:

- The general identifiers that are used to enter student behaviors in Skyward (our Student Information Systems)
- Some categories are more specific and some are more general
 - The general categories are used to capture a variety of student behaviors
 - Some of the more general categories are:
 - Failure to Follow Rules: FFR
 - Disrupting Educational Process: DRN
 - Potentially Dangerous Behavior:
 - P09 and P21
 - The State requires districts to report suspension/expulsion for “general” misconduct in two different ways:
 - Code 09 is for misconduct that warrants suspension/expulsion for the first offense
 - Code 21 is for suspension/expulsion due to progressive discipline
 - Multiple occurrences of the same or similar behavior that results in progressively more severe corrective action
- The charts below show all of the NKSD categories with some explanation for some of them. These are the documents that the schools work off of.

Actions:

- For the purpose of this report, actions represent the general suspension types that were used
 - In School Suspension
 - Out of School Suspension
 - Emergency Expulsion
 - Expulsion
 - Expulsions aren’t necessarily for 90 days
 - The length of an expulsion may be determined by the school, to be less than one calendar year. And, in one case, the student was readmitted after a few weeks.

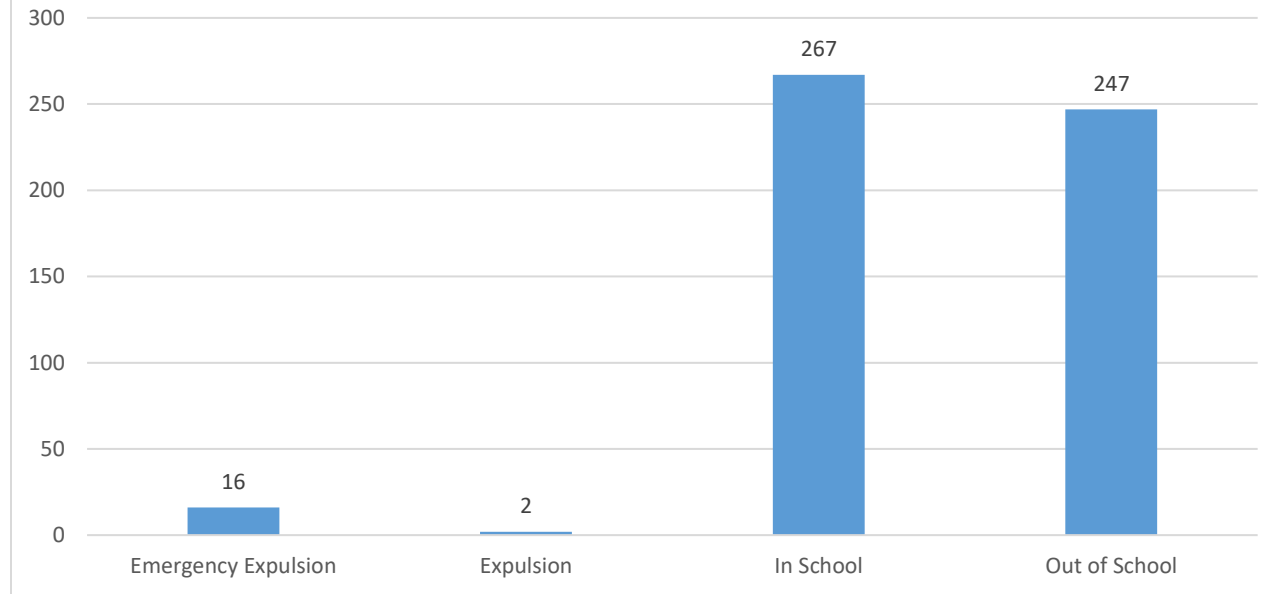

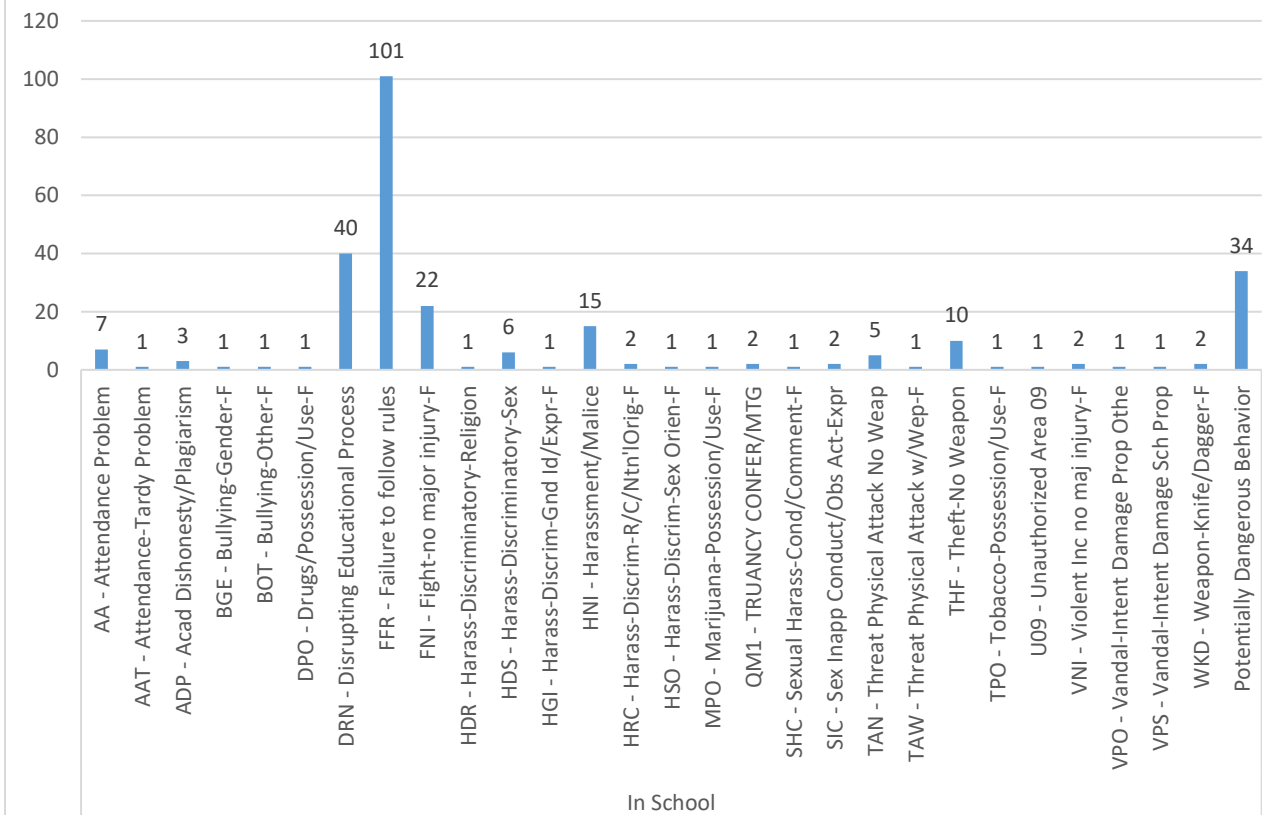

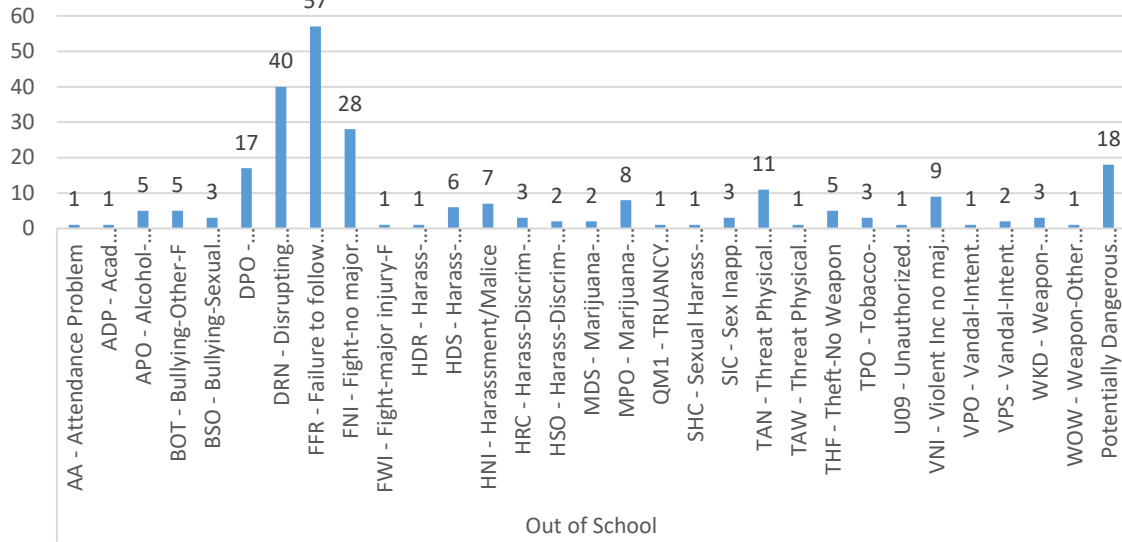
NKSD Total Suspension/Expulsions



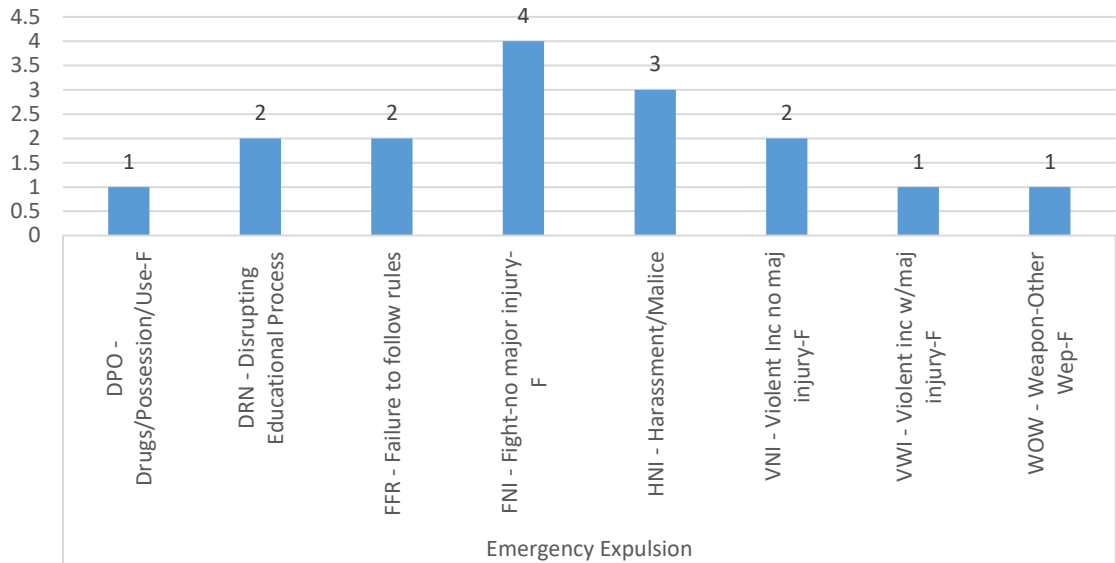
NKSD In-School Suspensions by Suspension Type



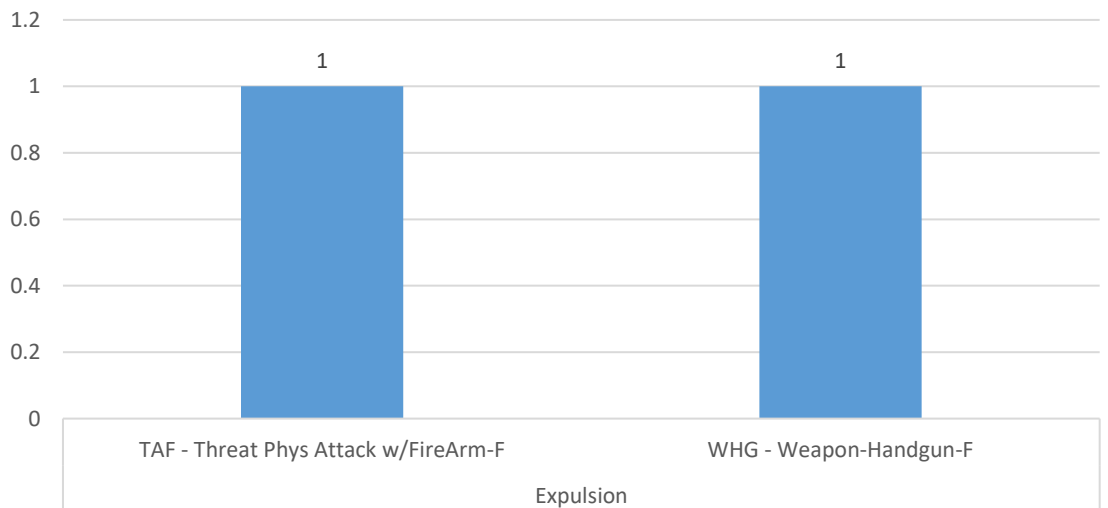
NKSD Out of School Suspension by Offense Type



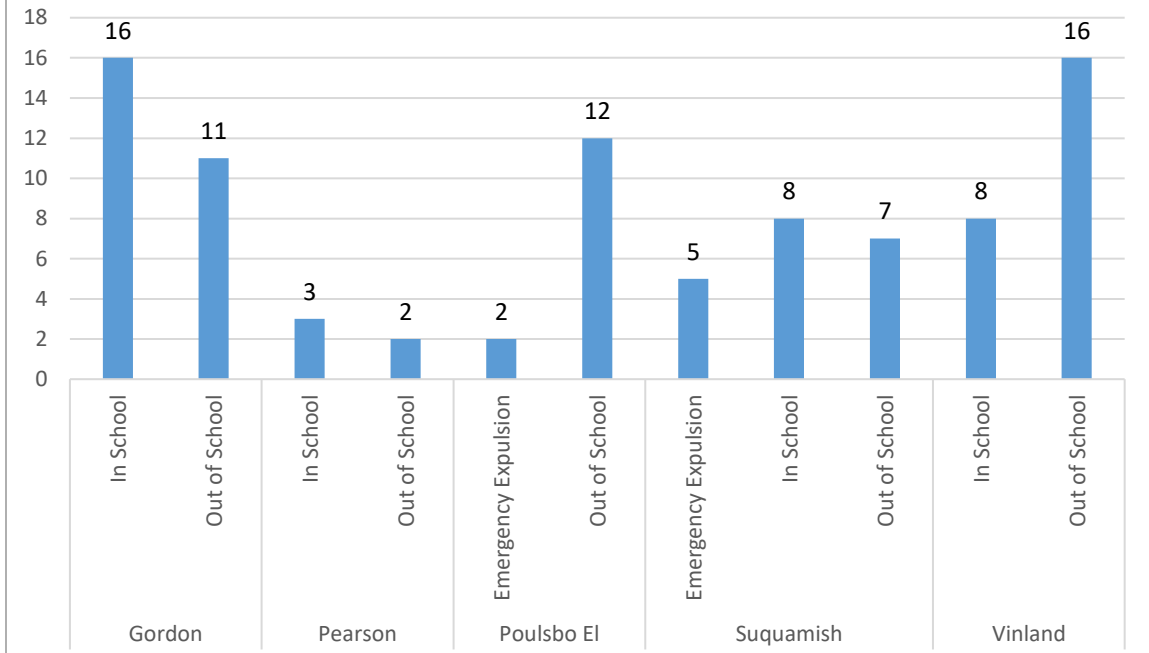
Emergency Expulsions by Offense Type



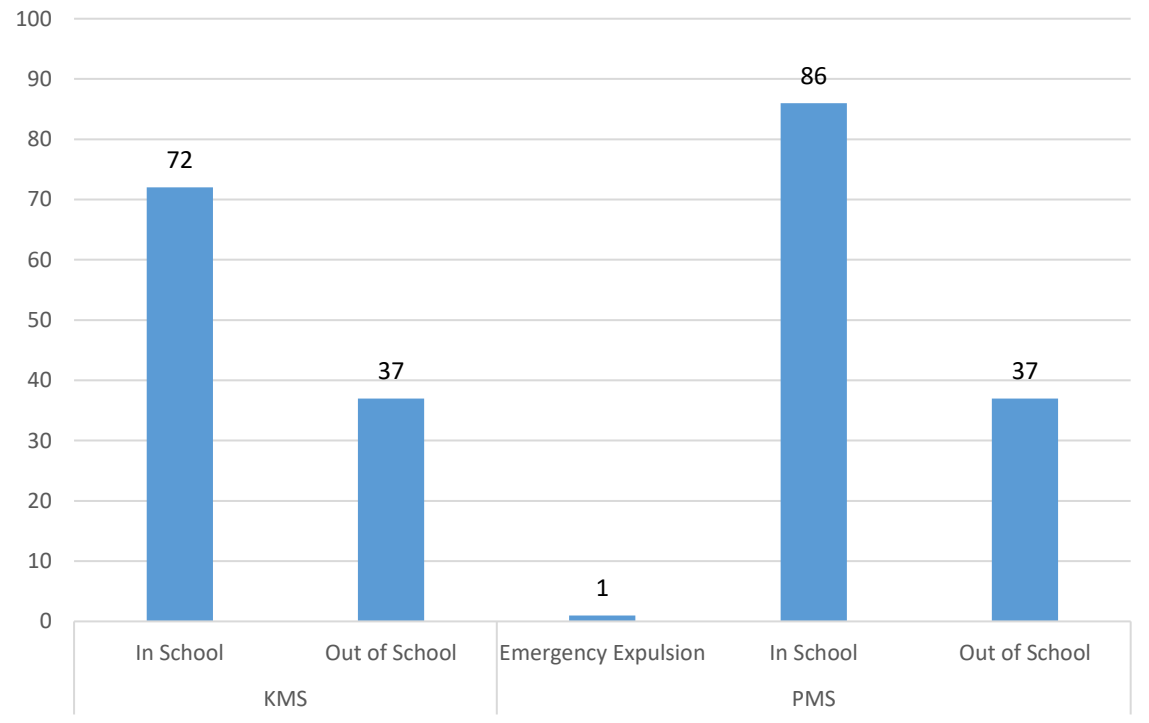
Expulsions by Offense Type



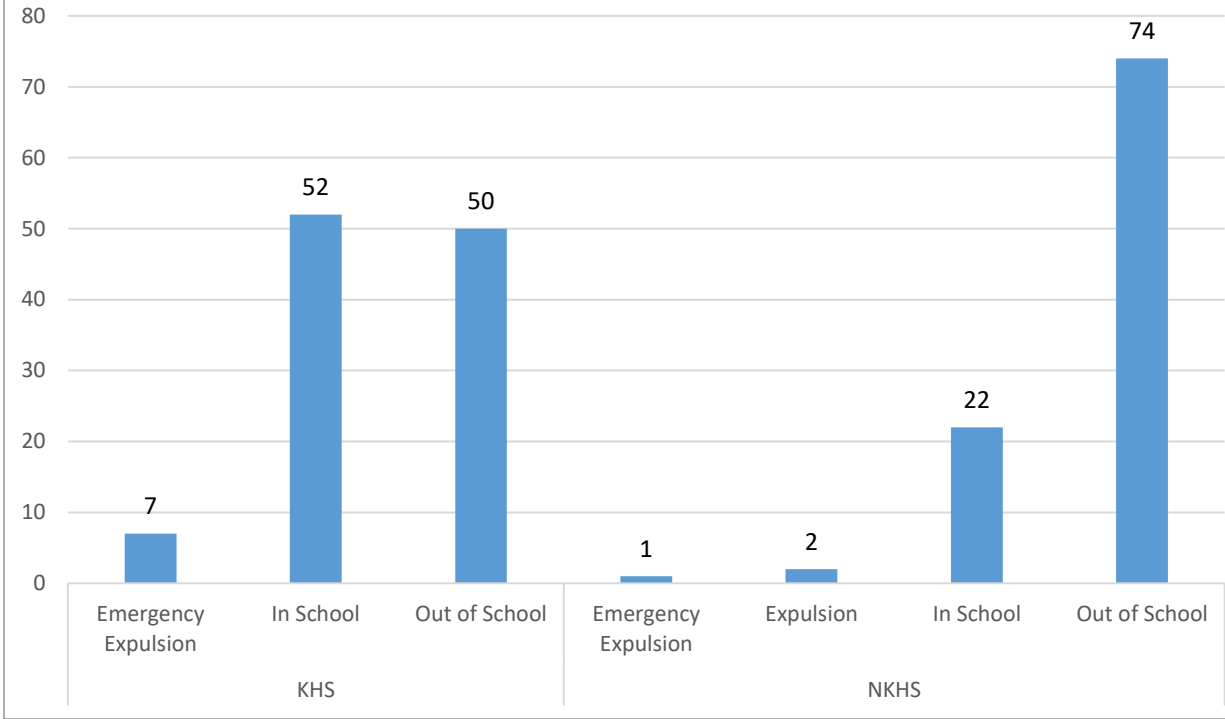
Total Susp/Exp for Elementary Schools



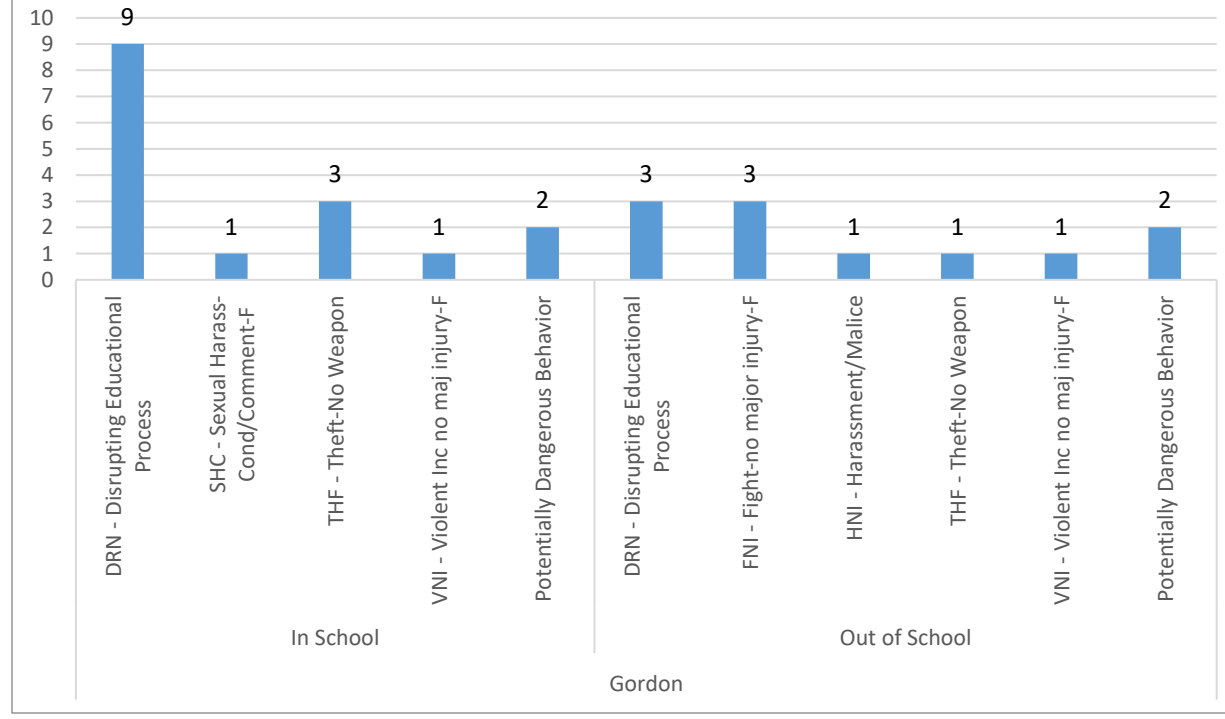
Total Susp/Exp for Middle Schools

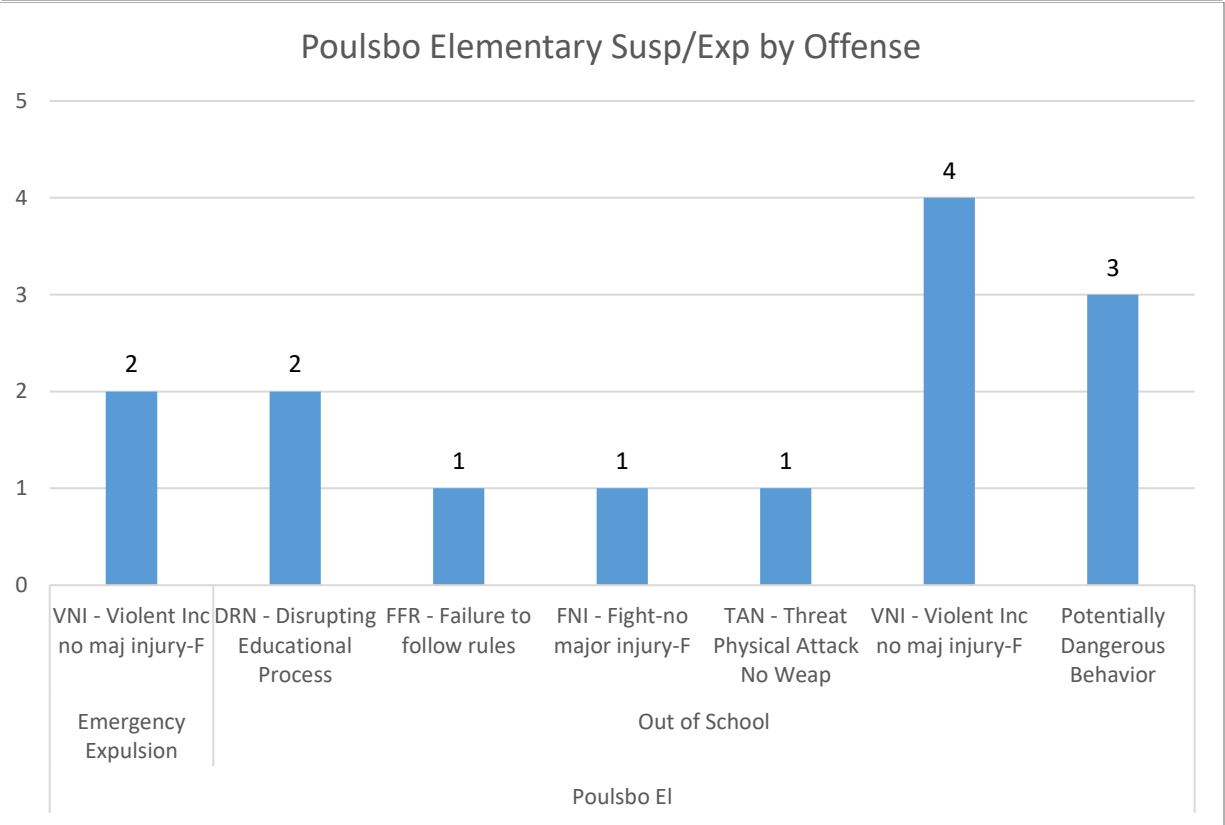
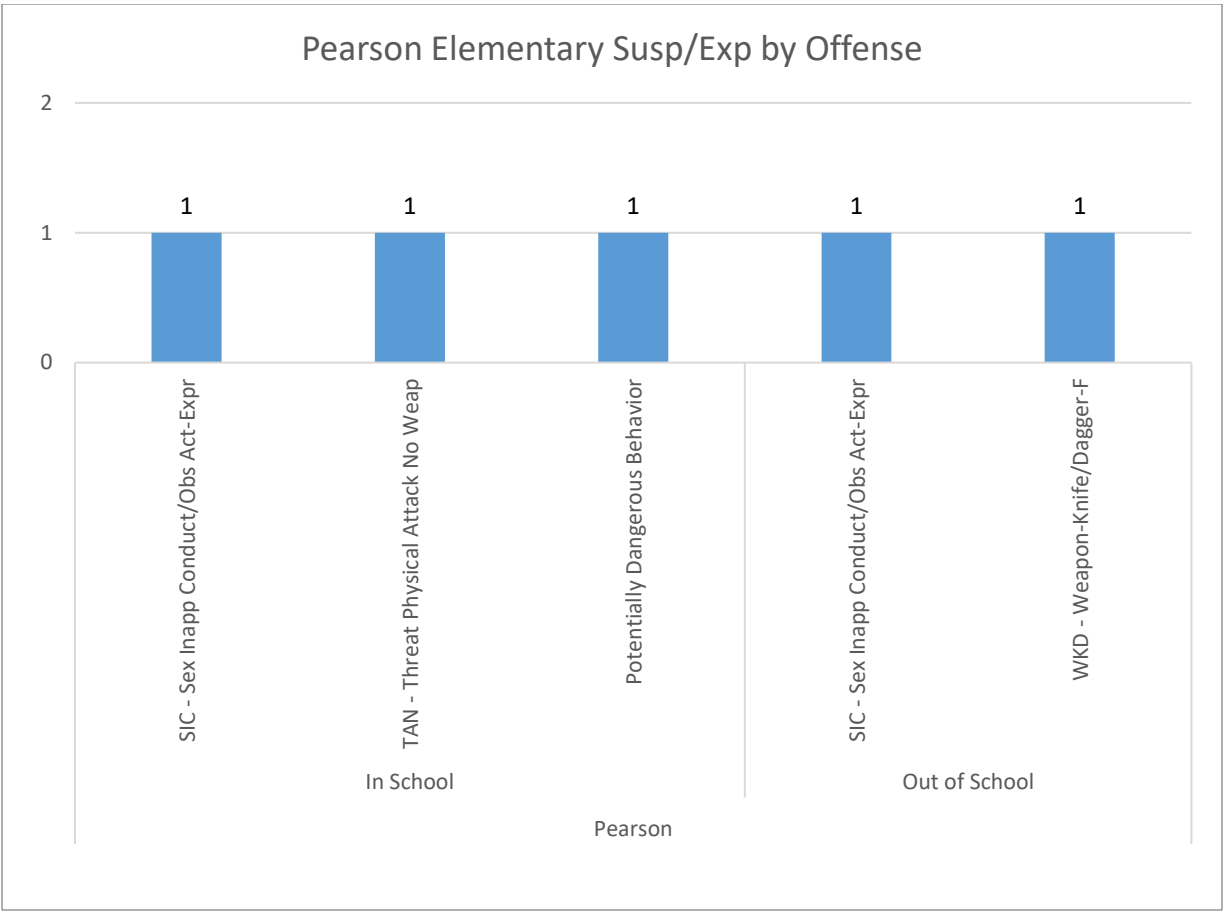


Total Susp/Exp for High Schools

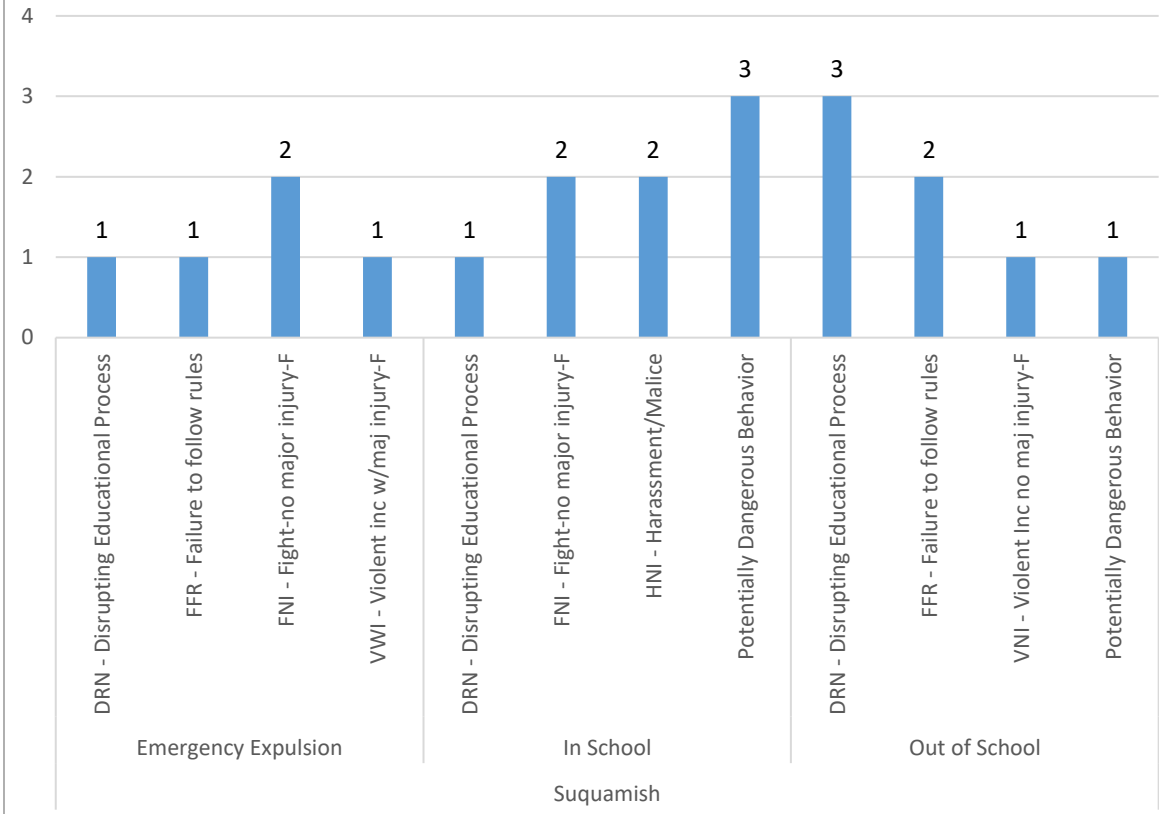


Gordon Elementary Susp/Exp by Offense Type

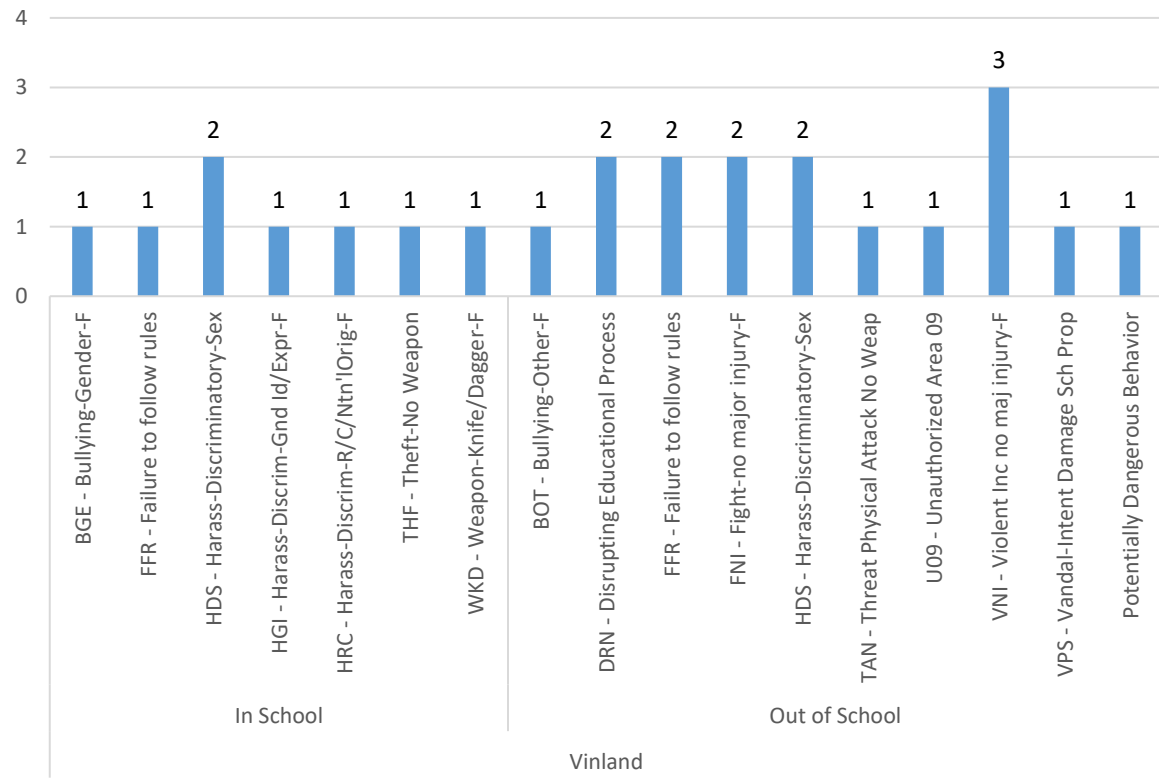


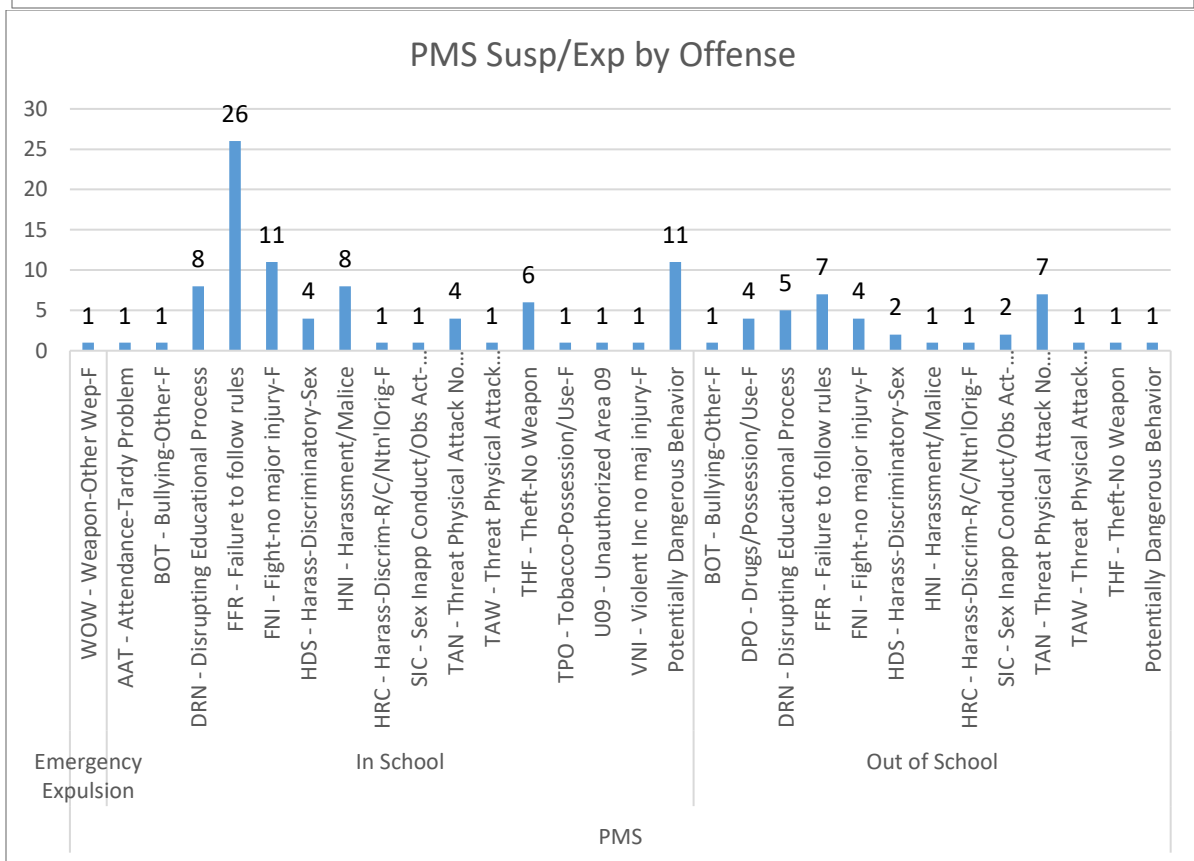
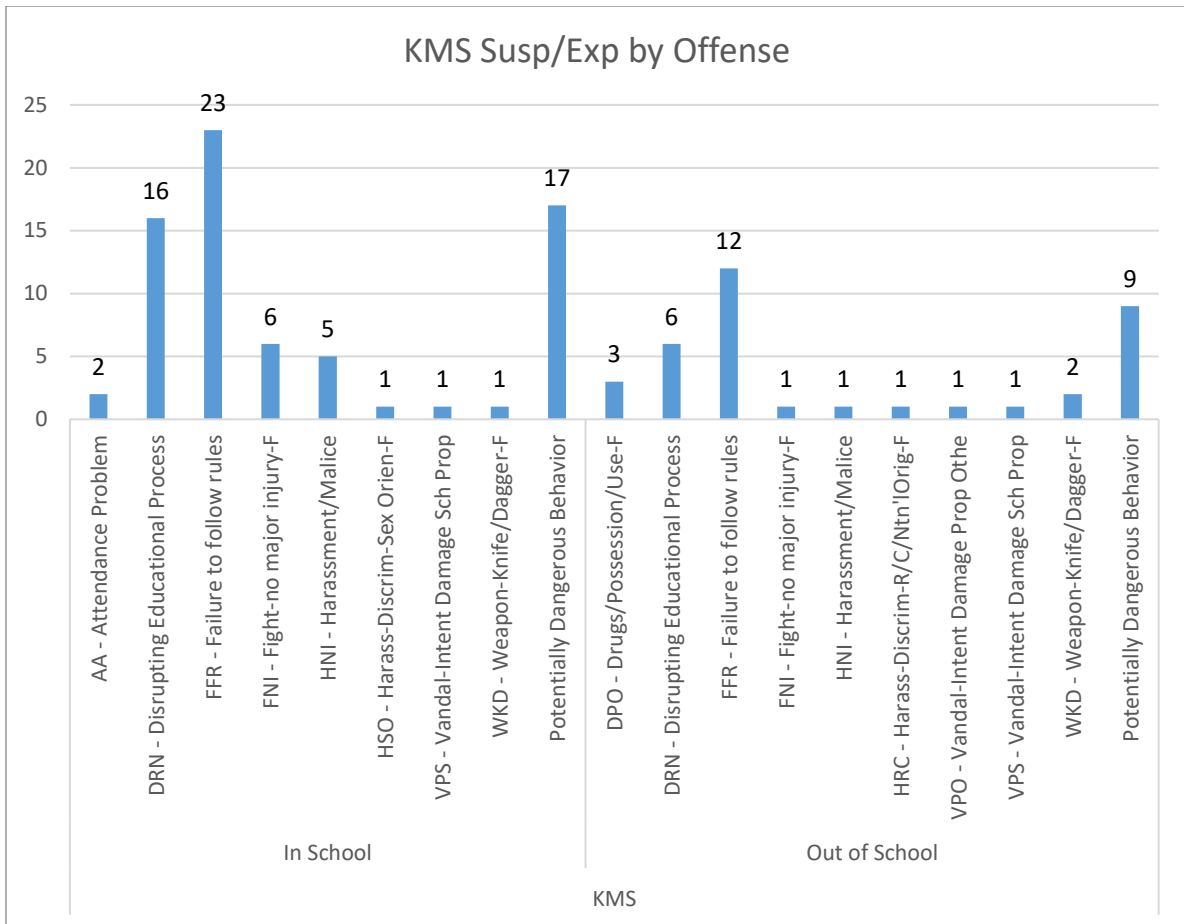


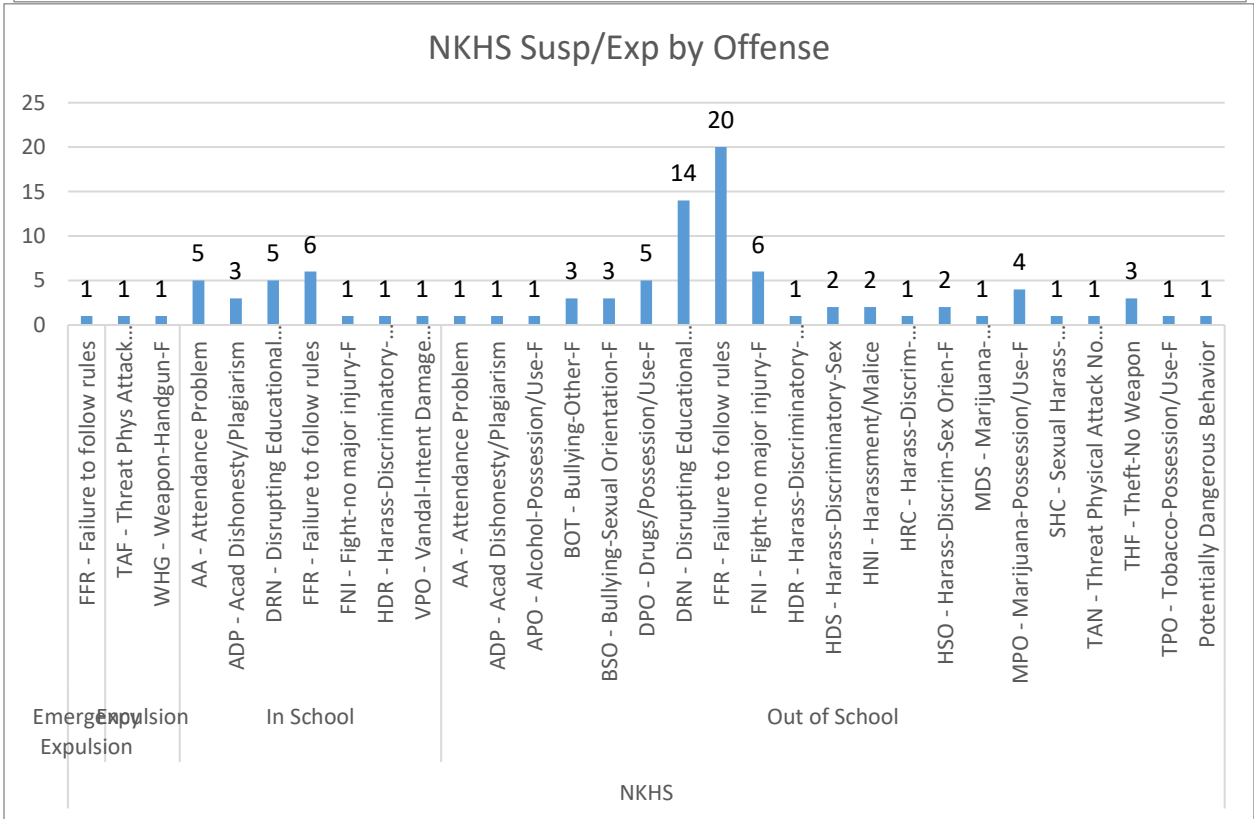
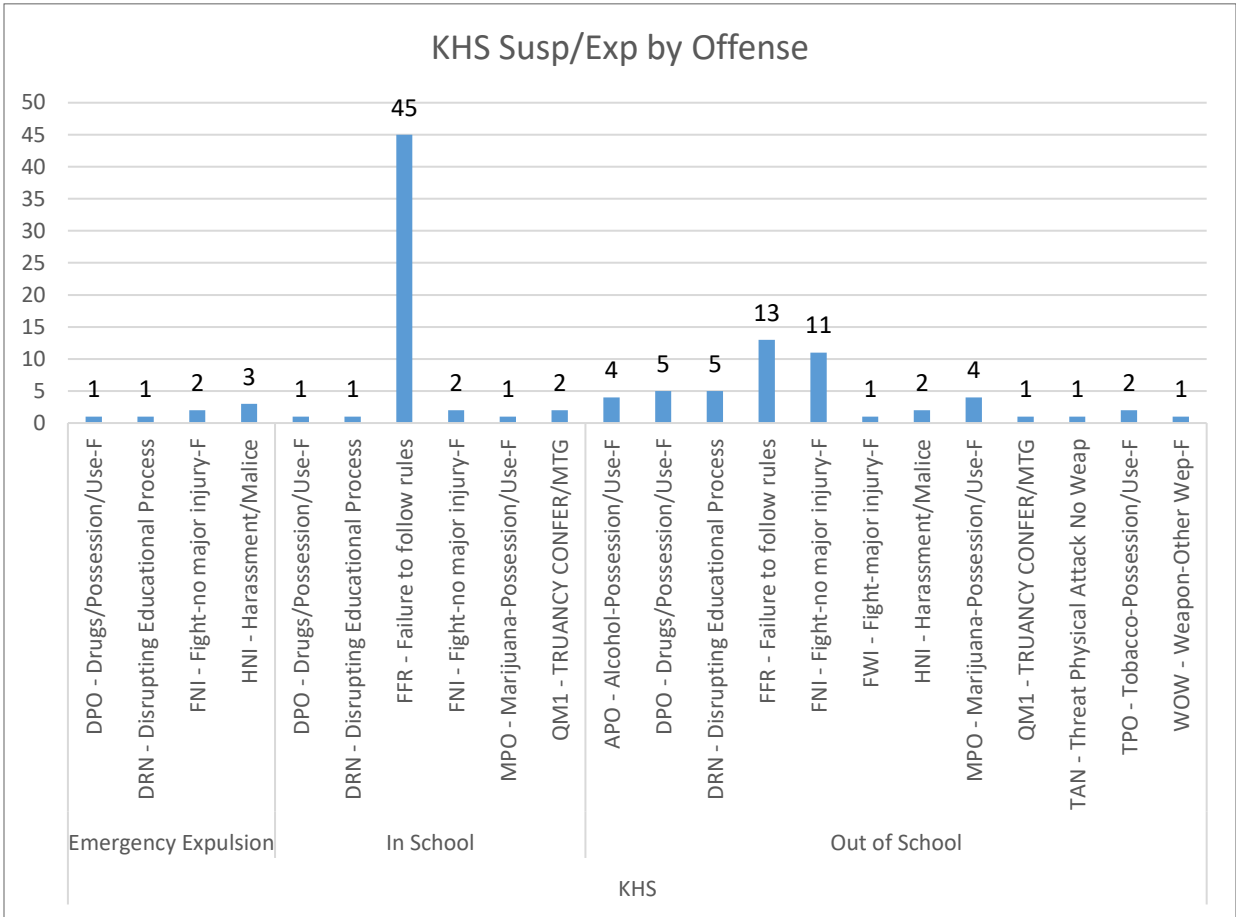
Suquamish Elementary Susp/Exp by Offense



Vinland Elementary Susp/Exp by Offense

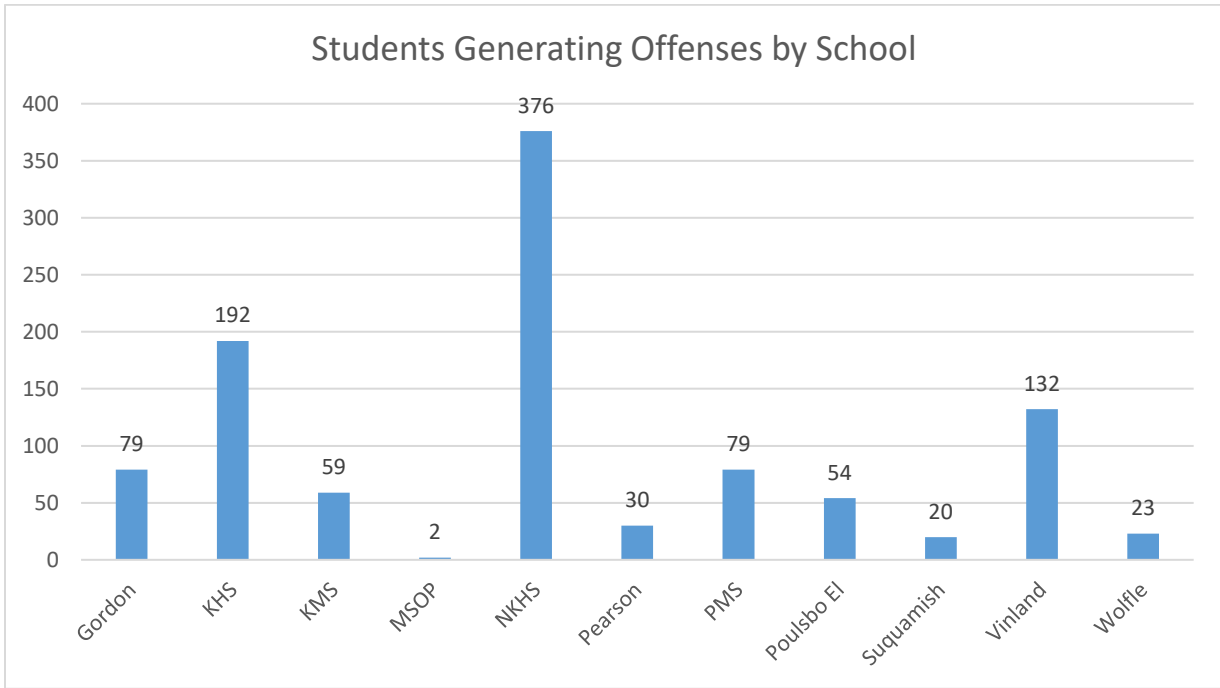
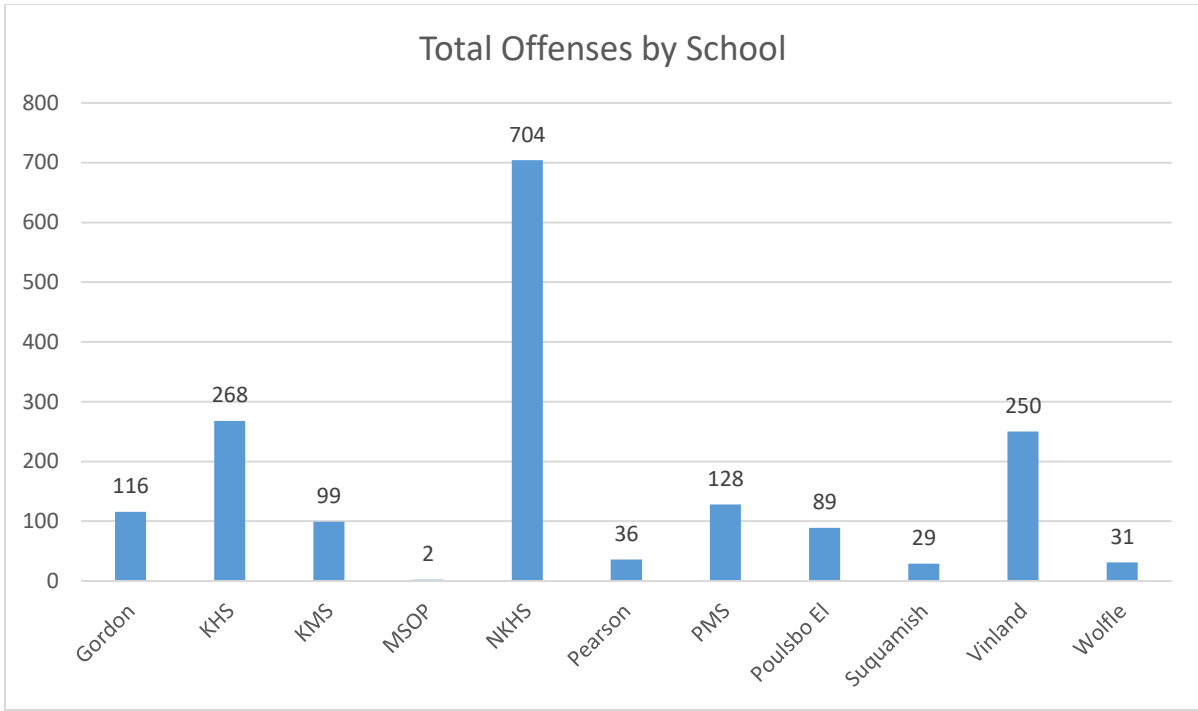




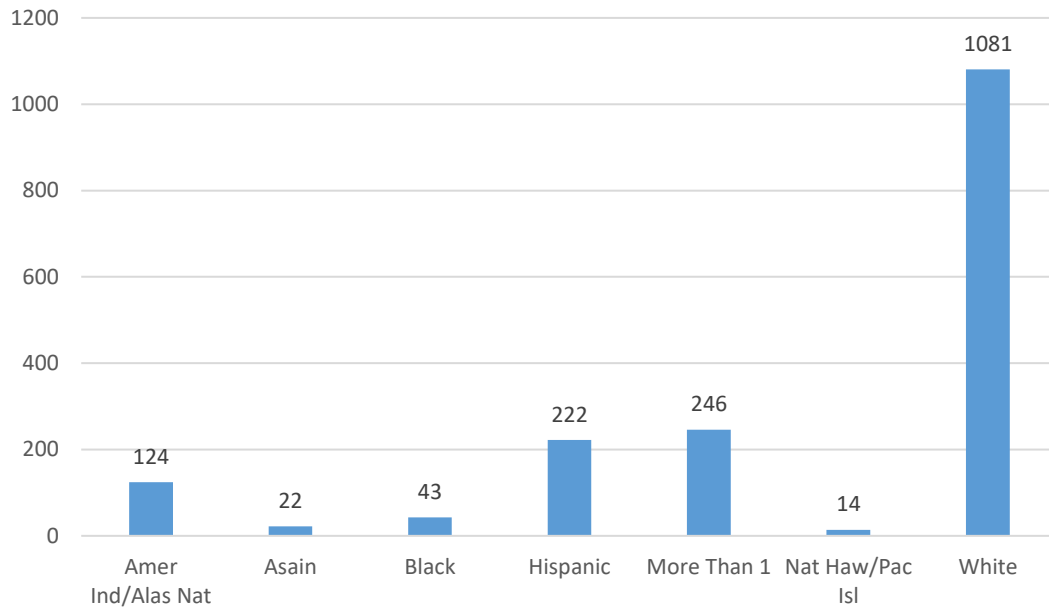

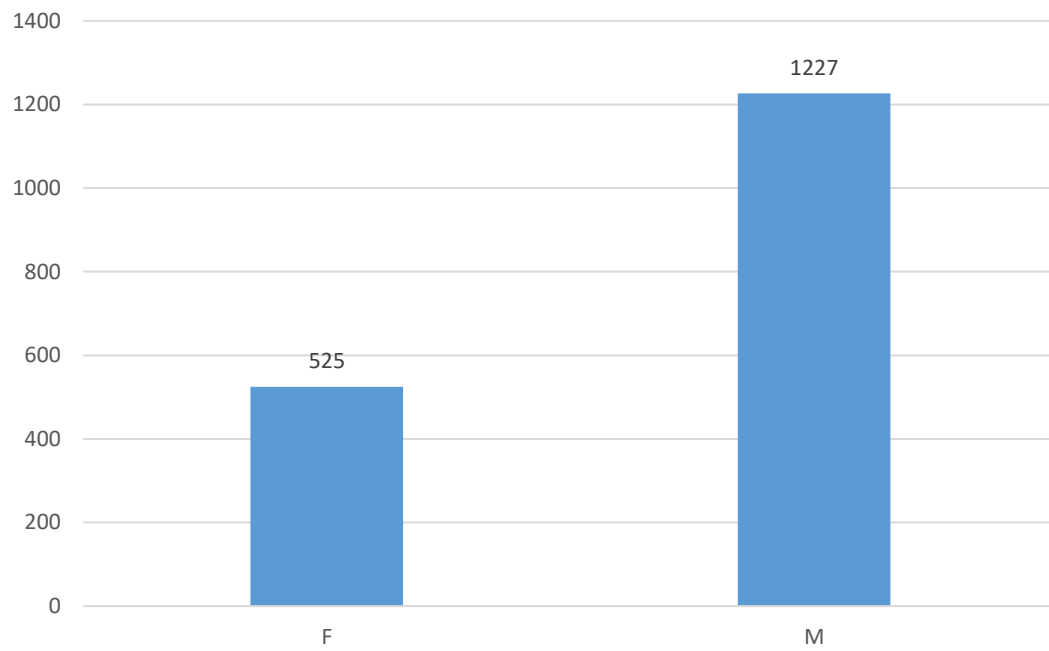

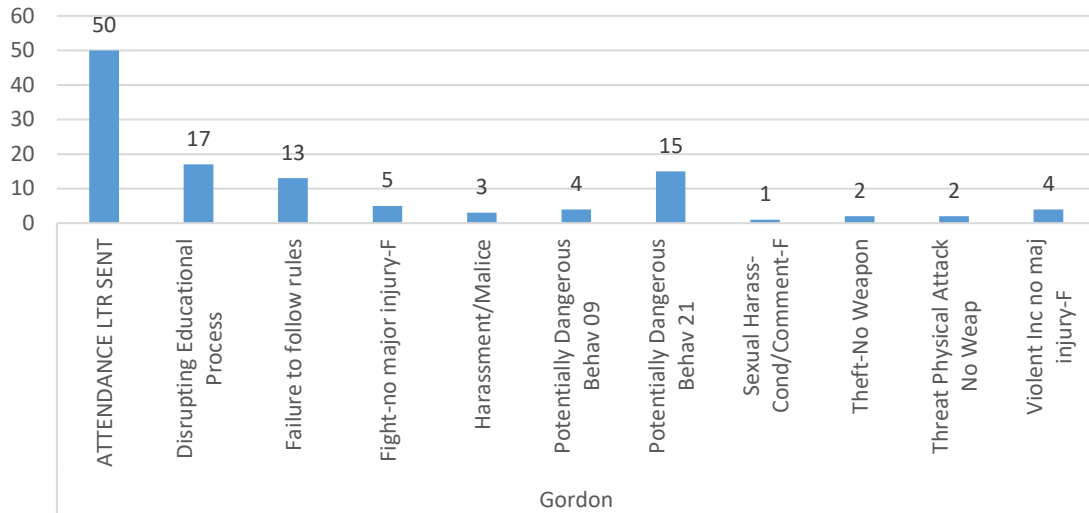
NKSD Total Offenses by Race



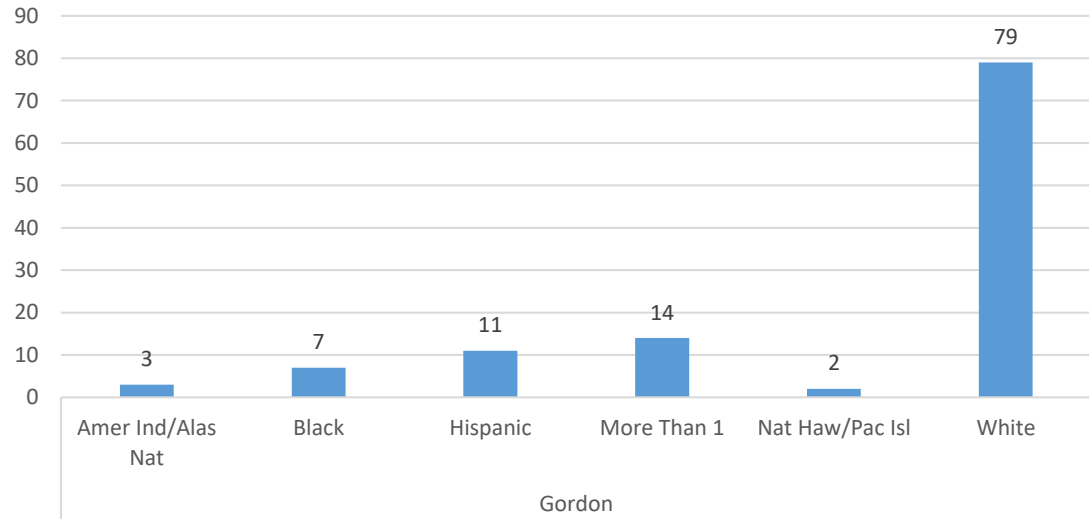
NKSD Total Offenses by Gender
